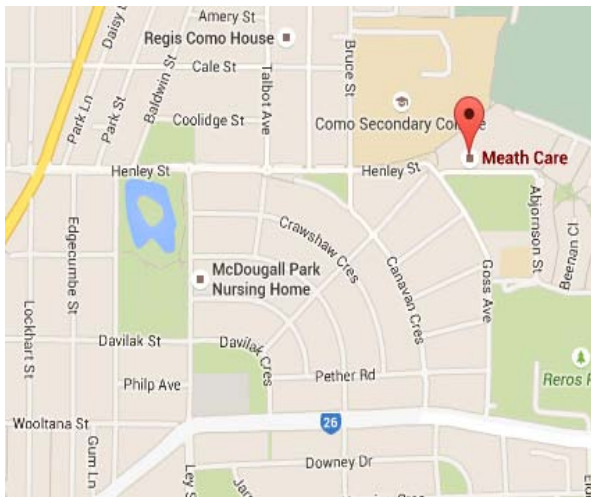

What does a Volunteer with Meath do?

As a Volunteer you will work under the guidance of the Occupational Therapist who will provide clear parameters on the activities you will do with the residents.



The Occupational Therapist will be your first point of contact with any questions or concerns you may have during your time with the residents.

As a Volunteer some of the things you might do could include:

- Supporting a resident with a walk
- Reading with/to a resident
- Supporting the Men's group
- Providing Support with outings
- Assisting with group activities ie. Bingo



How can you become a Volunteer with us?

- 1) Make initial contact with us via phone or email.
- 2) You will be asked to complete a Volunteer application form. We do ask you to provide as much information as you can regarding your skills and interests as this helps us match you with like minded residents.
- 3) The Facility Manager will make contact with you to arrange a time to come into the facility to meet them or the Occupational Therapist.
- 4) You will complete a full orientation and meet OTA Staff who will introduce you to the residents.
