

Dear Residents and Representatives,

Unfortunately, I begin this update by informing you of a positive resident case at Dr Mary Surveyor Centre, Kingsley (“**DMSC**”).

The affected resident is on **Darch (Second Floor)**. They became unwell today and subsequently tested positive by RAT mid-afternoon. The resident had returned a negative RAT during the mass screening on 15 March 2022 (Tuesday). Clinipath have been contacted and will attend to undertake a PCR test to confirm the RAT result.

We are working with Public Health to assess the situation and, as part of our outbreak management, we need to take immediate action to minimise any further exposure. **Accordingly, we have closed DMSC to all visitors, except for Essential Visitors such as Partners in Care.**

Further to my update yesterday, all residents on Shenton (First Floor) were screened earlier and **all returned negative RATs**. We shall continue to monitor them for any symptoms of COVID-19.

We have had no further instances of staff cases since yesterday, but we are prepared for further cases as the community numbers continue to increase.

At the Michael Lee Centre (“**MLC**”), all residents on Tuart and Karri returned negative PCR tests from the mass screening yesterday. These results have been communicated to Public Health and we are awaiting guidance from them to confirm that we can move towards reopening these areas of MLC.

Thank you for your cooperation and acceptance of this difficult situation. Updates will be circulated when further information is available.

## Conditions of visiting, from 17 March 2022

### Dr Mary Surveyor Centre, Kingsley

- All areas are closed to Visitors (except Partners in Care / Essential Visitors); and
- Partners in Care and Essential Visitors will undertake **Rapid Antigen Testing** on entry.

### Michael Lee Centre, Como

#### Tuart and Karri

- These areas are closed to Visitors (except Partners in Care / Essential Visitors); and
- Partners in Care and Essential Visitors will undertake **Rapid Antigen Testing** on entry.

### All other areas (Jarrah, Sandalwood, Olive, Wattle, Sheoak, and Tyalla)

- All visitors must **wear a mask at all times** within the Centre;
- All visitors must be **fully vaccinated** against COVID-19 or have a valid exemption;
- Visitors must declare that they have undertaken **Rapid Antigen Testing** in the **previous 4 hours** and have a **negative** result (NB - daily visitors - in the previous 72 hours);
- A **maximum of 2 visitors** at any time, and a **maximum of 2 visitors** per day;
- Visits must either occur in the **resident's room** or in **outside areas**;
- Visitors must practise social distancing, hand hygiene, and cough etiquette;
- Visitors must not visit if they are **unwell**, been in **contact with confirmed or suspected COVID-19 case**, or visited a **potential COVID-19 exposure site**; and
- Visitors must not visit if they have been **overseas in the preceding 7 days**.
