

Dear Residents and Representatives,

Please find below a brief update relating to COVID-19 at Meath Care for Easter Sunday.

#### **Dr Mary Surveyor Centre**

We have received all the results from the PCR testing undertaken yesterday, and **we can confirm that 4 additional cases have been identified in Shenton**. This brings the total number of currently affected residents in this **outbreak cluster to 9 residents**. All residents remain on Shenton and are doing well and either presenting as asymptomatic or with only mild symptoms.

We can also confirm that **all residents on Darch and Perry returned negative results** from the PCR screening yesterday. Clinipath will return to undertake further PCR screening this Tuesday (19 April 2022) and the extent of the testing will be to Darch and Shenton only.

#### **Michael Lee Centre**

Clinipath will return tomorrow (18 April 2022) to undertake PCR testing to residents on Sheoak/Tyalla and Olive/Wattle.

Aside from wishing everybody a very happy Easter, I also extend our thanks for your continued support and cooperation at this challenging time.

## Conditions of visiting, from 15 April 2022

### Dr Mary Surveyor Centre, Kingsley

#### Shenton (first floor)

- This area is closed to Visitors (except Partners in Care / Essential Visitors); and
- Partners in Care and Essential Visitors will undertake **Rapid Antigen Testing** on entry.

#### Darch (second floor) and Perry (third floor)

- All visitors must **wear a mask at all times** within the Centre;
- All visitors must be **fully vaccinated** against COVID-19 or have a valid exemption;
- Visitors must declare that they have undertaken **Rapid Antigen Testing** in the **previous 4 hours** and have a **negative** result (NB - daily visitors - in the previous 72 hours);
- A **maximum of 2 visitors** at any time, and a **maximum of 2 visitors** per day;
- Visits must either occur in the **resident's room** or in **outside areas**;
- Visitors must practise social distancing, hand hygiene, and cough etiquette;
- Visitors must not visit if they are **unwell**, been in **contact with confirmed or suspected COVID-19 case**, or visited a **potential COVID-19 exposure site**; and
- Visitors who have been **overseas in the preceding 7 days** need to **inform us of their overseas travel on entry**.

### Michael Lee Centre, Como
