

Visiting hours

We permit visiting at any time at Meath Care, although please note that the Reception is staffed during the following hours:

Monday-Friday: 0900-1600 hours

Saturday / Sunday / Public Holidays: 0900-1600 hours

Outside of these hours the doors will be locked for security reasons, please visitors should alert the nursing staff by pressing the doorbell. The staff will ask you to complete the regular visitor screen and print your visitor label.

Please note – any visitors who are not displaying their visitor tag may be asked to leave the Centre as this is our assurance that you have completed the required screening.

Visiting precautions, from 27 January 2023

Baseline Precautions are in place at both Centres

Baseline precautions are being employed as there are less than 5,000 active cases and below 200 hospitalisations in WA currently.

- All visitors must wear a mask within the Centre in indoor areas where residents are present or likely to be present;
- All visitors should practice hand hygiene and cough etiquette; and
- Visitors must not visit if they are unwell, have been unwell in the preceding 48 hours, or have tested positive for / been diagnosed with an airborne respiratory illness (COVID, influenza, RSV).
